MESSING ABOUT IN BOATS – Day Programs

Young sailors learn how to live on and by the sea.

Lil' Scuppers – Ages 5 - 6



Time: 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM
Hours: 4 hours/day for 5 consecutive days
Price: \$160 (Members \$144)
Starting Dates: 6/27 (MAB1), 7/25 (MAB5), 8/22 (MAB9)

The perfect entry-level maritime program for building self-confidence and basic boating skills in a fun maritime environment. Students drive powerboats, scavenge the beaches for treasure, row mini-longboats, build toy boats and sail big boats.

Lil' Barnacles – Ages 6 - 7



Time: 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Hours: 7 hours/day for 5 consecutive days

If your child is ready for an ALL DAY program this is the perfect choice. Students journey out onto PT Bay on every boat we have (sailboats, rowboats, powerboats) and experience the sea as sailors focusing on beginning levels of how to sail, how to be safe while having fun and how to crew a boat - together!

Junior Mariners – Ages 7 - 10



Time: 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Hours: 7 hours/day for 5 consecutive days

Students take to the sea as a Shanghaied sailor learning the crafts and songs of a savvy sailor bound for imaginary destinations around the globe. Students explore local boat shops, search for messages in a bottle and sail large and smaller sailboats, row el toros and drive a wood power boat.

Junior Pirates – Ages 7 - 10

Hours: 7 hours/day for 5 consecutive days

Students get underway with a scurvy lot! They'll discover the real history of pirates through stories, treasure hunts and captaining their own vessel. It's a HARRRRRRR life on the sea but we manage to have boat loads of fun!

Junior Shipwrights – Ages 7 - 10

Hours: 7 hours/day for 5 consecutive days

Students will build a 10-foot boat then launch and row it; learn why boats float through exciting games, build small toy boats and sail big boats.

Beginner Classes – Ages 8 - 12

Mystery Bay Sailor – Ages 10 - 13 & 14 - 16

Mystery Bay Longboat – Ages 12 - 13 & 14 - 16



Time: 3 days
Hours: Depart Day 1 at 9 AM; Return Day 3 at 2 PM
Price: \$225 (Members \$202.50)

Age 14-16 Dates: 7/29 (MBLB2)

Row and Sail our Captain Vancouver replica 26-foot longboats in your team of 12 students. Students build leadership and maritime skills aboard. All meals, sleeping gear and safety gear included.

San Juan Island Longboat – Ages 12 - 14



Time: 5 days
Trip starts and ends in Anacortes, WA
Price: \$495 (Members \$445.50)
Age 12-14 Dates: 7/15 (SILB1)

Join up to 11 other students to row and sail a replica of Captain Vancouver's 26-foot longboat in the San Juan Islands. Anchor out in secluded harbors to explore pristine islands with breathtaking views. Students work hard together to build leadership skills aboard through learning traditional arts of the sailor and All meals, sleeping gear and safety gear included.

Sail Training aboard the Schooner Martha – Ages 12 & up



Hoist anchor, raise sail and chart your way to beautiful remote destinations aboard the fastest schooner on the Salish Sea. Sail-training, plus environmental activities, kayaking, onshore hiking and exploring.

Includes: Hands-on experience and instruction, 3 meals per day, snacks, plus curriculum (book *Complete Sailor*), and a crew shirt.
